Hi Parents and Teachers,

I hope everyone had a wonderful summer. For those of you who do not know me...my name is Dede LaBarre and I am the box top coordinator for Our Lady of Sorrows School. My daughter Gwen Oakley is in the sixth grade.

It's that time of year again! I know that you have box tops that you collected all summer...now is the time to send them into school. Collect your box tops, throw them in an envelope and put your child's Name and Grade on the front. The school will then forward the envelopes to me and I will count and submit the box tops.

It is very important that you put your child's grade on the envelope because we have a contest every year between the grades in the school. At the end of the school year the class with the most box tops collected will have a pizza party. Every year the top three grades are very close....our top winner last year collected over 2,900 box tops!

Last year was a low year for submissions. We only collected 8,500 between the school and the Parish of Our Lady of Sorrows. I would love to get the number up to over 10,000! Every couple of weeks I will include a chart in the weekend envelope with the numbers collected so that you will know where your child's class stands in the contest.

So start looking for products with the box top label, put them in an envelope and send them into school. Every box top counts for 10c towards our school. In the past, parents have wondered where this money is dispersed. In the past, we have given teachers gift cards to buy classroom supplies.
